



# What is the aim of the Sanitary Dignity Framework?

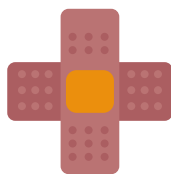
- To promote sanitary dignity of indigent persons and girls
- To provide norms and standards in the provision of sanitary products to indigent persons and girls (disaggregated by disability).
- To promote the addressing of girls' and women's rights including the rights of persons with disabilities
- To promote social justice
- To emphasise the basic human rights of indigent persons.
